Suffolk AHRC (Association for the Help of Retarded Children), the oldest and one of the largest voluntary organizations in the county serving children and adults with developmental disabilities, announces its offering of **GREAT TASTES OF LONG ISLAND: *Recipes From Favorite Chefs and Restaurants from The Gold Coast to The Hamptons.*** Seventy-one popular restaurants including Panama Hatties, The American Hotel, Pasta Pasta, The Grill Room, Barneys, Citanouva and Butterfields submitted recipes for this new cookbook, the publication of which provides jobs for the chapter's 600 men and women who are victims of the outsourcing overseas epidemic sweeping the nation.

AHRC's vocational training program for adults relies on outsourcing contracts from Long Island businesses to provide assembling and packaging jobs for its trainees. To address overseas competition the chapter is developing products of its own to provide enough work. This cookbook is such an endeavor. With a first edition of 5,000, this book is creating collating, spiral binding, and packaging jobs for the work centers. Its success will mean additional editions and further work.

GREAT TASTES OF LONG ISLAND offers home cooks the opportunity to recreate recipes which are currently popular at fine Long Island restaurants. The book is "user friendly". It is an 8" x 10", spiral bound book printed on high quality semi-gloss paper.
